

T-No.1 is an exclusive table series designed by Todd Bracher. The tables are designed to match the Oxford chairs, amongst others. The table tops are the series' signature feature and, regardless of material, they hover above the curved frame – in an altogether unique expression. All the table's details give it a light yet robust look. The T-No.1 series is available a wide range of lengths and is well suited as a conference table, office table, meeting room table and dining table.







TODD BRACHER 1974

Todd Bracher was born in New York, but moved to Copenhagen at the age of 24 to study design in the city where heroes such as Arne Jacobsen and Poul Kjærholm had lived. After his stay in Copenhagen he moved to Paris, Milan and London before returning to his roots this year and settling down in Brooklyn. He has now arrived at his own take on what constitutes good design, and that vision has come to expression in the new table he has designed for Fritz Hansen; a table which can be used both for meetings and for dinner.

Despite his New York roots, Todd Bracher's work takes the Scandinavian design tradition as its reference point. It was this fascination with Scandinavian design which took him to Copenhagen to graduate from Danmarks Designskole, and it was this feeling of belonging that made him an obvious choice for Fritz Hansen.

"All design is about the delicate balance between overdesigning and under-designing the object. I like the fact that the table looks as if it couldn't have been made in any other way. It is as if it was created in one long, natural movement." Todd Bracher.

"It's important for me that it doesn't demand too many explanations. There is nothing to understand - it is just a frame and a surface." Todd Bracher.



DESIGN

DESCRIPTION

An exclusive and flexible table series for conference, office and meeting use as well as private use, designed by Todd Bracher and manufactured by Fritz Hansen.

VERSIONS

Table tops are available in seven different variants and can be combined with three different frames.

Table frames

- High-gloss burnished aluminium
- Black powder-lacquered aluminium, gloss 50
- White powder-lacquered aluminium, gloss 50

Legs and wings are pressure-cast and cross bars are extruded.

Table surfaces

- 24 mm White laminate, with white laminate edges
- 24 mm Oak, with oak edges
- 24 mm Maple, with maple edges
- 24 mm Walnut, with walnut edges
- 24 mm Coloured ash in black with ash edges
- 15 mm Glass, F-edge, tempered glass with iron oxide
- 15 mm Underlacquered white glass, F-edge, tempered glass with iron oxide.

ENVIRONMENT AND TESTS

All frame parts can be disassembled for recycling. Aluminium frames can be melted down and re-used. Table tops in veneer and high-pressure laminate can be incinerated. Glass table tops can be recycled or sent to a landfill.

The table has been tested in accordance with:

- prEN 15 372 Non domestic
- EN 1730:2000, level 4 according to DS/INF 131
- EN 12521:2000 Domestic
- EN 527-3:2003 Office
- Surface resistance level 5 according to DS/INF 132.

GUARANTEE

We offer a five-year guarantee against manufacturing defects in standard products (materials and workmanship). Wear, tear and damage to the product are not covered under this guarantee. Claims from end users under the guarantee must be submitted to the vendor from whom the product was purchased.

RANGE AND MEASUREMENTS

Table top widths 100 (TB1-TB3), 120 cm (TB5-TB7) and 140 cm (TB9-TB11).

Table top lengths

200, 240 and 280 cm

The following is a selection of the available range and corresponds to the drawings shown. Table extension leaves can be joined arbitrarily to form longer tables. A table always starts and ends with the end legs. There is no limit to the number of table tops that can be joined together end to end. The width of the table top remains constant for the individual table.

ACCESSORIES

Cable trays

Cable trays are made from formed aluminium sheets, which have been anodized on both sides. The outline drawings show which cable trays correspond

to the individual table lengths.

Lengths:

60 cm (TB1 A, TB1 B, TB2, TB5 A, TB5 B, TB6, TB9 A, TB9 B, TB10)
80 cm (TB1 C, TB2 A, TB2 B, TB3, TB5 C, TB6 A, TB6 B, TB7, TB9 C, TB10 A, TB10 B, TB11)
95 cm (TB1, TB2 C, TB3 A, TB3 B, TB3 C, TB6 C, TB7 A, TB7 B, TB7 C, TB9, TB10 C, TB11 A, TB11 B, TB11 C).

Cable covers

2 cable covers – rectangular or circular, for veneer and laminate table tops.

Rectangular, 32.5 x 13 cm

Circular, Ø 8.8 cm.

ASSEMBLY

The customer assembles the legs, wings and cross bar to form the frame and affixes the table top to the frame. Tables which consist of several veneer/laminate table tops are joined together with a fitting. The glass table top rests on a rubber strip on top of the frame. The cable tray is to be attached by the customer. Assembly instructions and tools are included.

MAINTENANCE

Clean the table top and the frame with a dry or moist cloth. When cleaning with a moist cloth, wipe afterwards with a dry cloth.

Stubborn stains on the table top and frame can be removed with a cloth wrung in warm water. If this does not work, a weak solution of universal cleaning product or washing-up liquid can be used. The table top should thereafter be wiped with a cloth wrung in clean water and dried with a dry cloth. Laminate table tops can also be cleaned with laminate cleaning products.

PACKAGING

Legs, cross bars and ribs are packed individually in cardboard boxes.


The glass table top is packed in a wooden box and is dispatched standing upright on a wooden pallet. Veneer and laminate table tops are packed in export cardboard boxes or wooden boxes.


Cable trays are packed in cardboard boxes.

WEIGHT

Examples of estimated weight - 2 models
TB1 - 100 x 200 cm, veneer - approximately 53 kg.
TB7 A, TB7 C, TB7 B - 120 x 840 cm, glass
- approximately 459 kg.

Table weight does not include cable trays and packaging.
