PK58 is a minimalist table inspired by PK54. Thus it is based on PK54, but the design has been adjusted so that PK58 is taller and comes in a different selection of materials: Aluminium base with table top in a polyester compound.

DESIGN

DESCRIPTION

PK58 is a round table whose design is based on PK54. Designed by Poul Kjærholm and manufactured by Fritz Hansen.

FINISH

The table top of PK58 is moulded in polyester with added ATH (alumina trihydrate – a natural mineral filler). The base is made of anodised aluminium. The base is assembled using 16 black hexagon socket screws which combine the 16 parts into the cube that makes up the base.

PK58 differs from PK54 by being 1.5 cm taller and by the 10 cm shorter diameter of the table top (Ø 130cm).

DIMENSIONS

All measurements are for guidance only.

Diameter: 130 cm Height: 70.5 cm

Base: 10 x 25 mm and 10 x 35 mm.

MAINTENANCE

The base can be cleaned with a universal cleaning agent. Do not use chlorine or chlorous cleaning agents, hydrochloric acid or alkaline cleaning agents.

Wipe the table top with a dry or moist cloth. After wiping with a moist cloth use a dry cloth to wipe the table top dry. To remove stubborn spots, use a weak solution containing a universal cleaning agent. In case of particularly stubborn spots try using a concentrated universal cleaning agent and wash afterwards.

ENVIRONMENTAL FRIENDLINESS AND TESTING

The table can be completely disassembled into parts to be recycled or incinerated.

PACKAGING

The table is packaged in styrepor blocks, wood strips and a cardboard box. The table comes unassembled.
