The series of tables by Pelikan Design features an ultra-thin, almost "floating" tabletop – square, rectangular or circular in many sizes. The Plano tables are available in standard height for many different purposes as well as in a coffee table version.

DESCRIPTION

Square, rectangular and circular tables with 4 legs and "floating" table top for cafeteria, seminar, conference and the home.

FINISH

The table top is available in:

- 13 mm MDF plate with lacquered maple veneer. The applied lacquer is a polyurethane lacquer that does not give off formaldehyde.
- 13 mm white synthetic laminate
- 10 mm glass with white lacquered underside.
- 10 mm glass with grey lacquered underside.

The table is available with satin or mirror chromed base. The base consists of square profiled steel with edges in moulded zinc. The four legs are cylindrical Ø38 mm steel tubes that are mounted or dismantled without tools. The legs have chromed steel feet with hidden synthetic ferrules. The feet can be adjusted by 30 mm in height without any tools. The square or rectangular tables can be linked by the length, width, in an angle and into horseshoe set-ups with fittings in black-grey anodized aluminium. These are installed and dismantled by means of black-grey

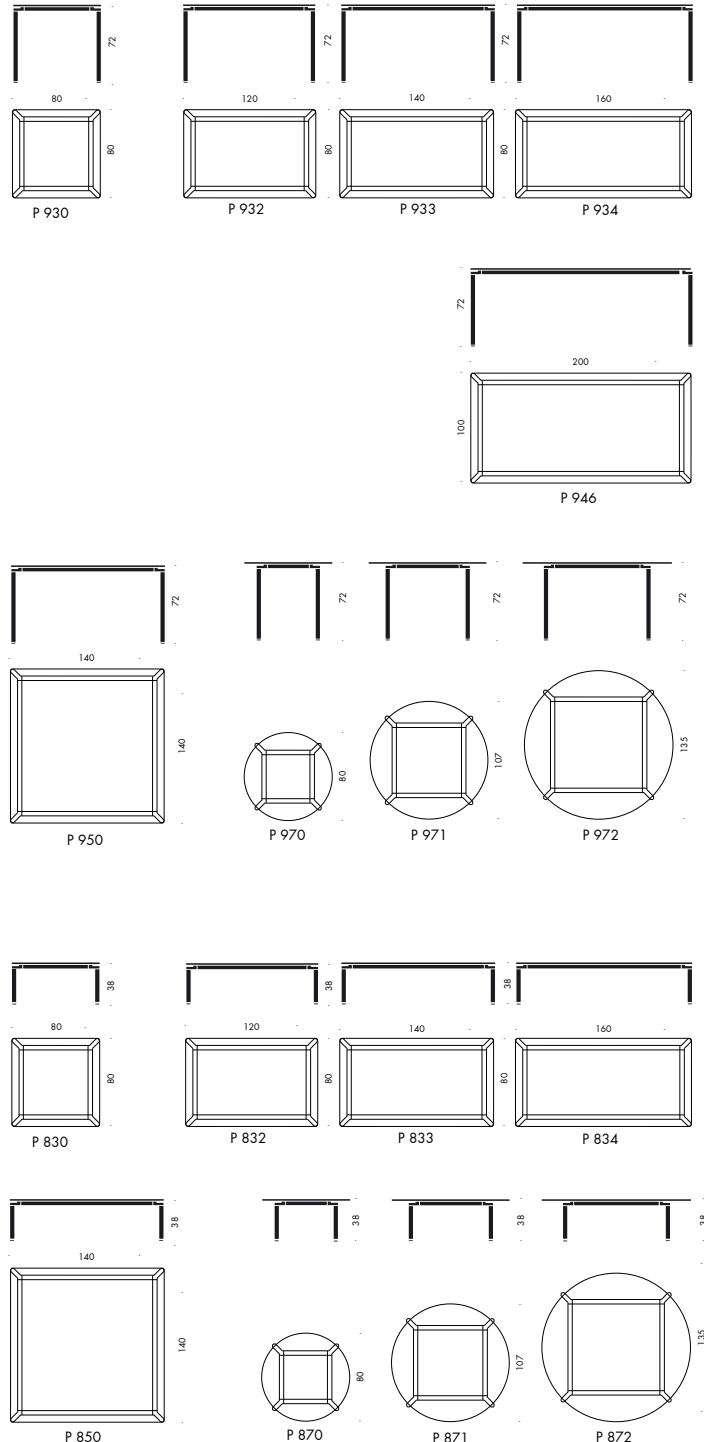

All models are available with satin or mirror chromed steel.

MAINTENANCE

Table top and base are wiped off with a dry or moist cloth. Any excess water should be dried off with a dry cloth.

Dirt stuck on the table top should be removed with a cloth wrung in lukewarm water. If this does not remove the dirt a solution with all-purpose cleaner or liquid detergent should be used. Subsequently the table top should be dried off with a dry cloth.

ENVIRONMENT AND TESTS

The steel base and the pressure moulded zinc edges can be dismantled for recycling. Table tops made of MDF, in lacquer or with synthetic laminate are combustible. Table tops made of glass are recyclable or may be left for waste disposal.

The tables are tested according to:

- ISO/DIS 8019 Stability, strength, durability, test level 4.
- ISO 7172 Stability
- Surface resistance, test level 5 according to DS/INF 132.

GUARANTEE

A five-year guarantee against manufacturing defects in standard products (materials and workmanship). Wear, tear and damage to the product is not covered under this warranty. Claims from end users under the guarantee must be submitted to the vendor from whom the product was purchased. All measurements are indicative.
